

Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 3 and 4 children from Budbrooke Primary School have been invited to take part in the Hampton Magna Lantern Walk on Sunday, 1st December to celebrate the start of the Christmas season in the community.

The lantern walk will start at Damson Road at 5pm where groups from the village and the school will stop to sing three carols as they walk towards Budbrooke Community Centre. They will finish the walk on the green opposite the Community Centre to sing one more carol together. At around 5:30pm they then enter the Community Centre where others are gathered who do not do the walk.

The evening then commences with music, poetry, invited guests, and further performances from the Budbrooke Primary School singers who will be singing Christmas carols.

Afterwards there are refreshments, mulled wine, juice for the children, mince pies, cakes, biscuits and the event should finish by 7pm. Children will need to be supervised by a parent for the duration of the event.


